INSTRUCTIONS.

PART 1:—Parade and Service.

1.—**Assembly Parade Grounds.** Old Palace Yard and Parliament Square, Westminster.

2.—The Parade, assembled by Companies from the several ships, known as **K, L, M, O, Y**, together with a contingent composed of Canadian ex-Service men resident in this country **BP** (British Party) will be formed in two detachments, (i) Khaki Berets (ex-Service men); (ii) Blue Berets (Relatives). The Khaki Beret Detachment will form up on Old Palace Yard, the Blue Beret Detachment in Parliament Square.
